Fee Waiver Pilot Program

- In June 2015, the Commission approved the allocation of \$3,000 for one year to provide fee waivers for court-appointed attorneys who meet specified criteria.
 - Applications for fee waivers were to be evaluated based the percentage of the applicant's practice focusing on indigent defense cases and the financial need of applicant (especially for new or solo practitioners).

> The points assigned to each factor were selected such that no single factor would result in automatic approval or denial of the request. A combination of factors is needed for approval of the request.



Approved Procedure

- If an applicant scores at or above the threshold set by the Commission, staff will approve the waiver.
- If the application scores below the threshold, staff will forward the application to a Commission member for review.
 - Commission member may consider approving the waiver due to a special circumstance (such as when the applicant included other information that may warrant an exception).

Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission announces fee waiver program

In June 2015, the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission approved a fee waiver program for attorneys who perform court-appointed work in the Commonwealth. Through this one-year pilot program, attorneys providing court-appointed representation may qualify for a waiver of the fees the Commission charges private attorneys to attend a sentencing guidelines training seminar or to purchase a guidelines manual. Attorneys who would like to request a fee waiver must submit an application. Applications for fee waivers will be evaluated based on the percentage of the attorney's practice focusing on indigent defense cases and the financial need of the applicant (especially for new or solo practitioners). Attorneys approved for a fee waiver will be able to attend guidelines training and/or receive a manual free of charge. Applications will be accepted while funds designated for the pilot project remain.
