





Agreement Is Needed on How to Capture Signatures in **SWIFT!**

Conformed Signature Protocol

OES has adopted the use of a "conformed signature" protocol within many of its applications that generate documents to be processed within the judiciary. The Virginia Judiciary Electronic Filing System (VJEFS), the Digital Appellate Records System (DARS), the Electronic Voucher Payment System (EVPS) that is now in pilot, and the District Electronic Filing System (DEFS) soon to be in pilot all utilize this feature. Additionally, this standard has been utilized by the Federal Judiciary for many years in their Case Management/Electronic Case File (CM/ECF) and Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) systems. A sample produced by EVPS where the signatures of the vendor (attorney), clerk and judge are all captured using the conformed signature format, "/S/User Name" are included in the presentation.

The act of signing a document, regardless of the format of the signature, has served as the standard required to communicate a document's approval by an individual or institution since the history of human writing. The conformed signature is a modern industry standard used for document generation within automated systems utilizing a secure sign on protocol. Every authorized user of the system is assigned an individual user name and password, thereby providing a high level of assurance that the name placed on the document represents the user who was logged into the system at the time of approval. The conformed signature simply provides a visual representation of the user's approval on the final document. This is generally deemed acceptable since there is no need to ever interrogate the signature on the document as is done today with traditional signatures, as the act of signing occurs on an automated system that can be audited to a far greater degree than traditional paper signatory acts can.

Utilizing the conformed signature format complies with the standards utilized by OES. This will greatly reduce both the time needed for development and the ongoing support costs over the life of the SWIFT application. The Commission staff has indicated there are no concerns with using this standard, but approval of the members of the Commission is sought before development starts on the module that provides functionality for a judge to approve and submit guidelines electronically.



APPLY FOR A SWIFT! ACCOUNT

SWIFT! is a system that is connected to existing court data.

This data is used to populate fields on the sentencing guidelines form. In the future, this connection will allow sentencing guidelines preparers to electronically share copies of guidelines with one another and to submit the final guidelines to the sentencing courts. Even then, the system can generate paper

Existing technology will still allow preparers to modify the worksheets up until the court accepts the electronic copy.

copies for jurisdictions that require paper.

The system will calculate the guidelines recommendations and populate the coversheet every time the final scores are modified.

In the future, the system will assist users in preparing the sentencing guidelines as it checks for common errors on the worksheets. In all cases, the preparer will make the final call on how a factor is scored.

This is the beginning of the automation process.

SWIFT! is the only way to complete sentencing guidelines and to print paper copies of the worksheets.


