



#### Issue 1:

## Scoring New Arrests During Current Supervision Period Includes:


- 1. Arrests for offenses that are dismissed or defendant found not guilty
- 2. Utilized for defendants convicted of the violation before resolution of the new offense



#### Issue 1:

## Scoring New Arrests During Current Supervision Period Includes:

- Incorporating new law violations
   (Condition 1) into the sentencing
   guidelines may reduce the need for this
   factor
- 2. Staff will be sensitive to this issue as analysis begins




#### Issue 2:

## Identifying Date Arrested on Capias/Violation

1. Currently the absconder factor is scored up to the violation hearing date

2. Difficult to identify date arrested for the capias/violation from available data sources




#### Issue 2:

## Identifying Date Arrested on Capias/Violation

1. Staff will attempt to identify arrest dates from court and criminal history records

2. Any suggestions for a better source of data?




#### Issue 3:

## Testimony and evidence presented in the hearing is not available

- Current Sources Limited to
  - Information on behavior while supervised
  - Major Violation Report
  - Criminal history in Virginia (not out-of-state)
  - Departure reasons

violation?





- 3. PVG recommendation potentially changing offender behavior (e.g., not scored on PVG & jail credit)





- 1. CCAP is different population than Detention/Diversion
- 2. Violation of CCAP is not scored at all on PVG
- 3. PVG recommendation potentially changing offender behavior (e.g., not scored on PVG & jail credit)
- 4. Proposal to suspended completion of sentencing guidelines for CCAP violations





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
