
### Changes in Felony Larceny Threshold in Virginia



- Prior to 2018, Virginia's felony larceny threshold was \$200.
  - Last changed in 1980.
  - Tied for lowest in nation at that time.
- Many offenses in the Code of Virginia are "deemed larceny" (punishable in the same manner as larceny) or were otherwise affected by changes in the felony larceny threshold.
- The 2018 General Assembly passed legislation to increase the felony larceny threshold from \$200 to \$500.
- The 2020 General Assembly increased the threshold to \$1,000.
  - This the median value for all 50 states.



## Charges for Larceny and Other Offenses Affected by the Felony Larceny Threshold (All Court Levels)






Notes: In order to avoid double-counting in this chart, charges in General District Court or Juvenile & Domestic Relations Court that were certified to the grand jury or otherwise certified to Circuit Court were excluded (these charges will be counted in Circuit Court files). Similarly, appeals from General District and Juvenile & Domestic Relations Court were excluded. Circuit Court data do not include cases from Fairfax or Alexandria as clerks in those jurisdictions do not participate in the statewide Case Management System. Analysis of Juvenile & Domestic Relations Court data includes only adult offenders processed in JDR Court.






