


Nonviolent Offender Risk Assessment Completion Issues

2009 ANNUAL REPORT




More than two-thirds of all guidelines received by the Commission for FY2009 were for nonviolent offenses.

However, only 40% of these nonviolent offenders were eligible to be assessed for an alternative sanction recommendation.

Nonviolent offenders who are recommended for probation/no incarceration on the guidelines are not eligible for the assessment.

Furthermore, the instrument is not to be applied to offenders convicted of distributing one ounce or more of cocaine, those who have a current or prior violent felony conviction, or those who must be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of incarceration required by law.

In addition to those not eligible for risk assessment, there were 3,144 nonviolent offense cases for which a risk assessment instrument was not submitted to the Commission.





Analysis has revealed that certain circuits are more likely than others to submit guidelines forms for eligible offenders without a risk assessment form.
