








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Preliminary FY2009 Probation Violation Guideline Cases by Type of Original Offense* n=3,520

Preliminary FY2009 Conditions Cited in Probation Violation Guidelines Cases* n=3,520







Preliminary FY2009 Probation Violation Guidelines Most Frequently Cited Departure Reasons

Mitigation (24.2%)

- 376 of 824 have written departure reasons
- Most frequently cited:
 - Progress in rehabilitation
 - Mitigating facts of the case
 - Plea agreement
 - Substance abuse issues
 - Offender's health
 - Minimal prior record
 - Needs to pay costs/restitution


Aggravation (21.9%)

- 393 of 743 have written departure reasons
- Most frequently cited:
 - 2nd/subsequent revocation
 - Poor rehabilitation potential
 - Fail to follow instructions
 - Substance abuse issues
 - Absconded from supervision
 - Failed alternative treatment program
 - Needs rehab through jail/prison






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Preliminary FY2009 Sentencing Revocation Reports Type of New Law Violations (n=4,549)
