





#### **Most Common Reasons for Departure - Aggravation**







#### **Guidelines Compliance by Circuit**






#### **Guidelines Compliance by Offense Category**




#### **Percentage of Midpoint Enhancement Cases**




#### **Compliance by Midpoint Enhancement**




# **Most Common Reasons for Mitigation in Midpoint Enhancement Cases**




## Type of Adjudication




## Percent of Felony Convictions Adjudicated by Juries Parole v. Truth-in-Sentencing System




#### Nonviolent Offender Risk Assessment Impact
